Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, the charity you are supporting will receive an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue, helping your donation go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.80 just so long as donations are made through Gift Aid.

Higher rate tax payers can additionally, reclaim the difference between the higher and lower tax rates through their Self Assessment tax return
